1. Who do the characters in the parable represent?
2. What does this parable tell us we should be doing with what God has given us?

Friday, June 5th — Read Genesis 1:26-31

1. What was the last thing that God created?
2. What were Adam and Eve supposed to do?

Saturday, June 6th — Read 1 Peter 4:1-11

1. How are we to live our lives?

2. What should everything we do accomplish (v. 11)?
