The Book of Zechariah

Our sermon series for the season of Lent has been over the Book of Zechariah. This series continues on through Easter Sunday. Between now and Easter we are going to read through the Book of Zechariah. Now I know that the Book of Zechariah can be a tough read especially with the visions that Zechariah sees. However, one thing to keep in mind is that Zechariah is all about God's kingdom.

The setting is during the time period after a majority of the Israelites had returned from their captivity in Babylon. The reconstruction of the temple had begun, but it had come to a standstill because of some outside influence from those that were also living in Jerusalem at that time who were not Israelites.

In a simplistic way of looking at Zechariah, it was time to rebuild the temple, but they needed to repent of their wayward ways first. We can also see how when one is about the Lord's work, there are always evil forces that are trying to stop the work that is being done for the sake of God's

kingdom. But ultimately, God wins. He defeats the evil forces and God's people are rescued and saved.
