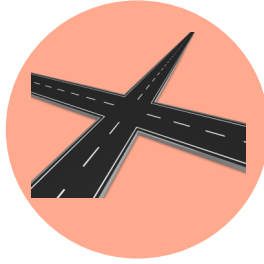

1. What is the cross to those of the world (non-believers)?
2. What is the cross to us as Christians?
3. What message does the world need to know?

Thursday, May 14th — Read Acts 14:1-12

1. Why were Peter and John arrested?
2. Where is salvation found?

Friday, May 15th — Read 1 Timothy 2:1-7

1. What is God's desire?
2. How is one saved?
3. What message is to be preached?

Saturday, May 16th — Read John 3:16-21

1. How is one saved according to this passage?

2. What happens to those who do not believe?

Memory Verse

Review the memory verse with your family each night.

1 Corinthians 1:22-23 For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles.
