God Sends the Final Plague

Lesson Summary

This week we looked at the final plague and how God protected his people. God had promised to make a great nation of the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob after a period of bondage. He was faithful to fulfill that promise, and the plagues on Egypt were all a part of his plan to bring the Israelites into the Promised Land.

We saw God's sovereign control over the events: he told Moses that Pharaoh would reject his command, and God also hardened Pharaoh's heart to bring about the outcome he had planned. As Proverbs 21:1 says, "The king's heart is a stream of water in the hand of the LORD; he turns it wherever he will."

Most importantly, we saw God's provision of salvation from the final plague of death as he passed over those who were protected by the blood of a lamb. This foreshadowed the Lamb of God who would come to take away the sin of

the world and offer his blood so that God's wrath against sin would be withheld from those who trust in Christ.

3. What was Pharaoh's and the Egyptians' response to this plague?

Wednesday, February 26th — Read Exodus 13:1-16

1. What were the Israelites to do with their firstborn?

2. How often was the Passover, Feast of Unleavened Bread, to be celebrated and why?

3. What are some of the things that we should continue to celebrate and teach our children?

Thursday, February 27th — Read Exodus 13:17-22

1. How is God still keeping His promise that He made with Moses when He called him to go back to Egypt?

2. How is God's presence made known?

3. How do we experience God's presence in our lives today?

Friday, February 28th — Read 1 Peter 1:13-21

1. How was Christ like the Passover lamb?

2. When did God ordain Christ's sacrifice on the cross (v. 20)?

Saturday, February 29th — Matthew 26:17-29

1. What meal was Jesus eating with the disciples?
2. What did Jesus do that made this meal unlike any other Passover meal prior to this time?
3. How is this a rescue meal for us like the Passover meal that rescued the Israelites?

Review the memory verse with your family each night.

Isaiah 41:10 Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
